



Oak Ridge Board of Education Long Range Planning Committee Looking for Members!

The Board of Education for the Oak Ridge R-6 School District is reestablishing the Long Range Planning Committee for the 2018-2019 school year. The Oak Ridge R-VI School District's Long Range Planning Committee (LRPC) was reestablished (first meetings were held during the 2015-2016 school year) in October as an advisory body to the Board of Education. The charge of the LRPC is to review:

- **Buildings, Grounds, and Usage:** LRPC members analyze population trend data, to evaluate population impacts on District education mission and support facilities, to collect community feedback, and to recommend appropriate actions to the Board of Education regarding school facilities (including new construction, renovation and/or public usage)
- **Technology:** LRPC members assess the implementation and usage of technology in the classroom and community to create a technology plan
- **Extra-curricular activities/community involvement:** LRPC members assist in assessing site feasibility for proposed uses by evaluating community impact and making recommendations on how sites should be used.

Finally, LRPC members help to review and evaluate the district annual Long Range Plan which contains recommendations for programs and projects that may be needed in the next five years. The LRPC plays a valuable role in serving as a liaison between the community and the Board of Education for the 2018-2019 school year.

Meetings are usually held the first Tuesday of each month (before the school board meeting) with additional subcommittee meetings as needed. Additional public meetings are occasionally held to review specific projects or policy changes with impacted stakeholders.
